What is The English Access Microscholarship Program?

Access is a U.S. State Department supported program which provides a foundation of English language skills to bright, economically disadvantaged students, primarily aged 13 to 20, in their home countries. Access programs give participants English, leadership and life skills that may lead to better opportunity and educational prospects.

The goal of the Access Program is to equip students, who possess a minimal knowledge of English, with effective communication and critical thinking skills through meaningful interaction, cooperative learning strategies, interest-appropriate activities, and real-life contexts.

Participants also gain the ability to compete for and participate in future exchanges and study in the United States.

Who can be eligible providers?

Burundian local educational or community organizations with official recognition.
